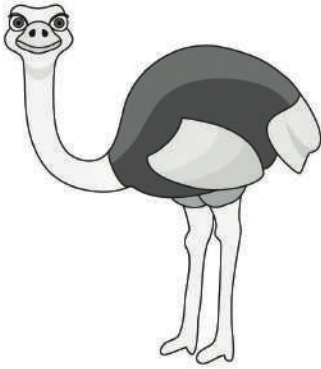

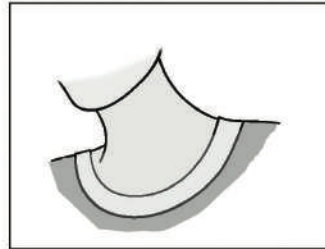

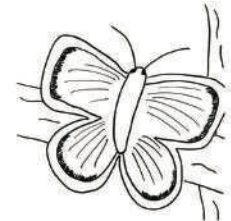
Do you know what makes a bird different from other animals?

Karner Blue Butterfly - insect



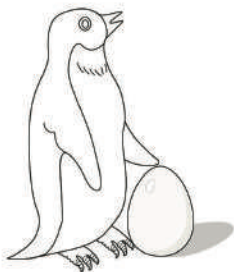
